
Frank Harte 1933 - 2005

"ince his teens, Fran was #ascinated with songs that tell stories and was an avid collector #or many years. +e amassed over (),))) songs, mainly #rom %eo%le he met at various "inging sessions. 1 ver the years he researched the historical and social conte2t #or many o# the songs, and annotated, and cataloged them to an e2tensive . atabase. . rawing on this database he %roduced a series o# C . s each o# which are little master%ieces which tell the story o# ma3or historical events in /rish history through the songs they ins%ired.






